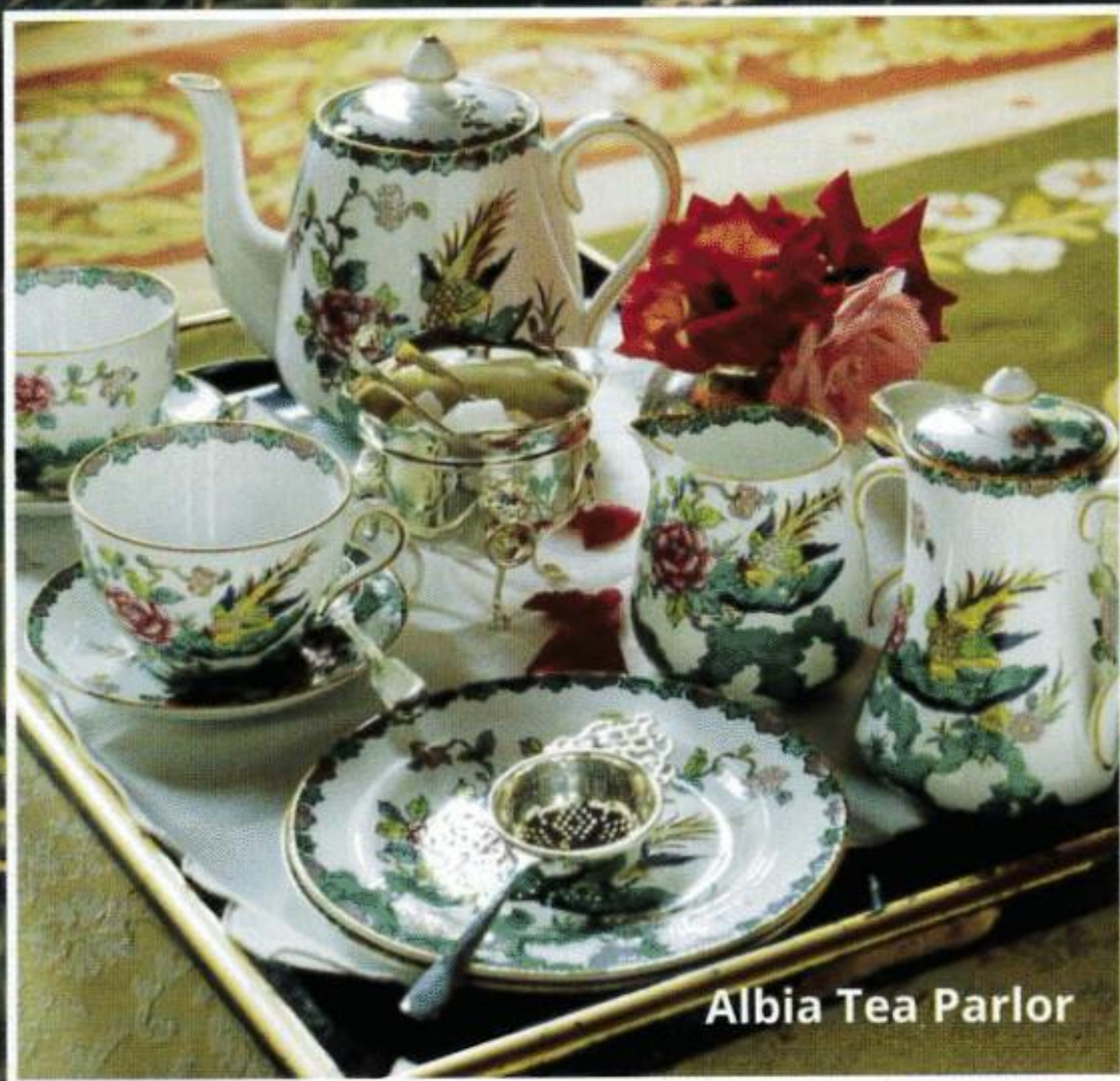

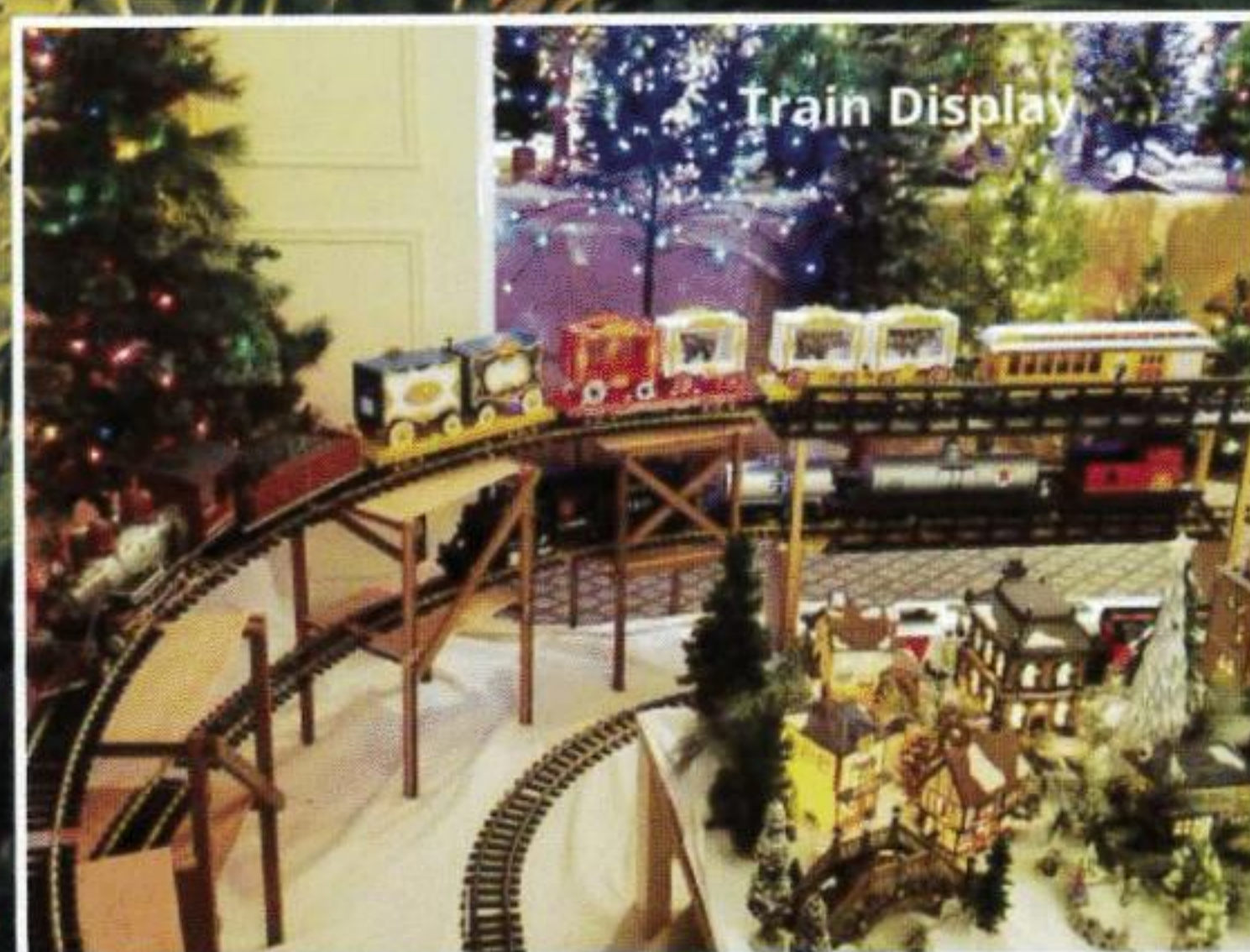
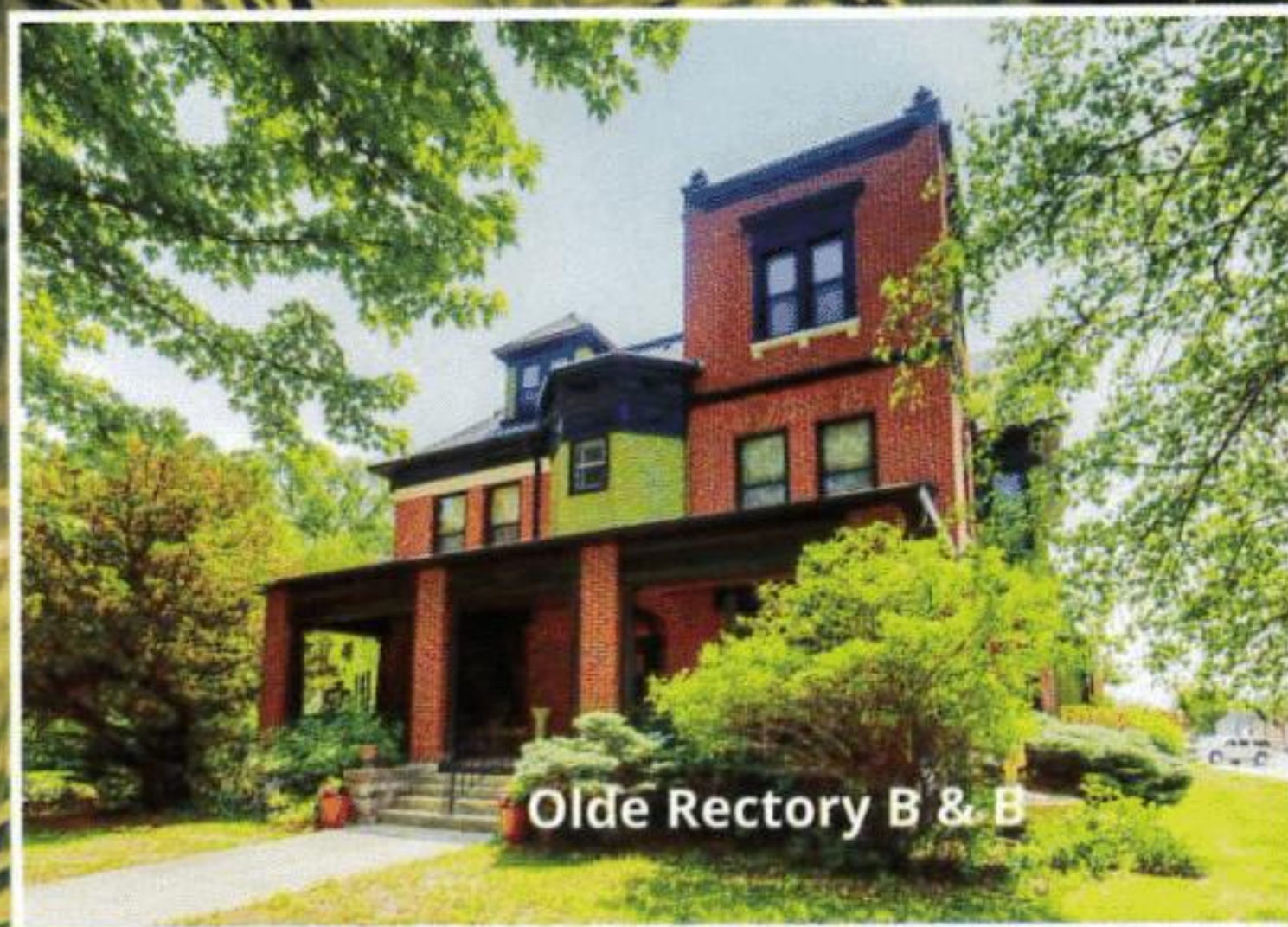
Trolley will return you to the square where you can continue on to view the train display and enjoy a complimentary drink at Golf 22. (map #18)

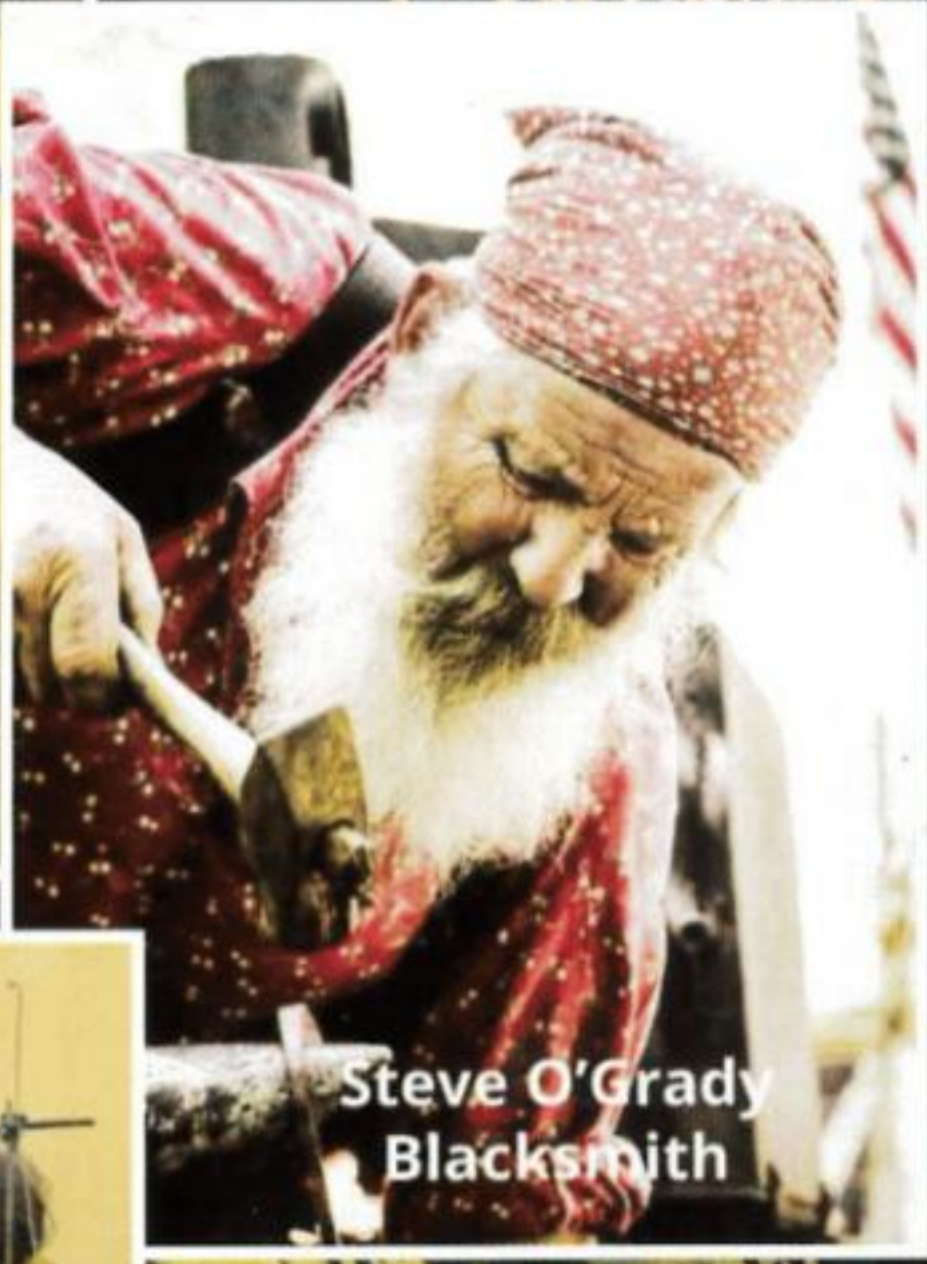

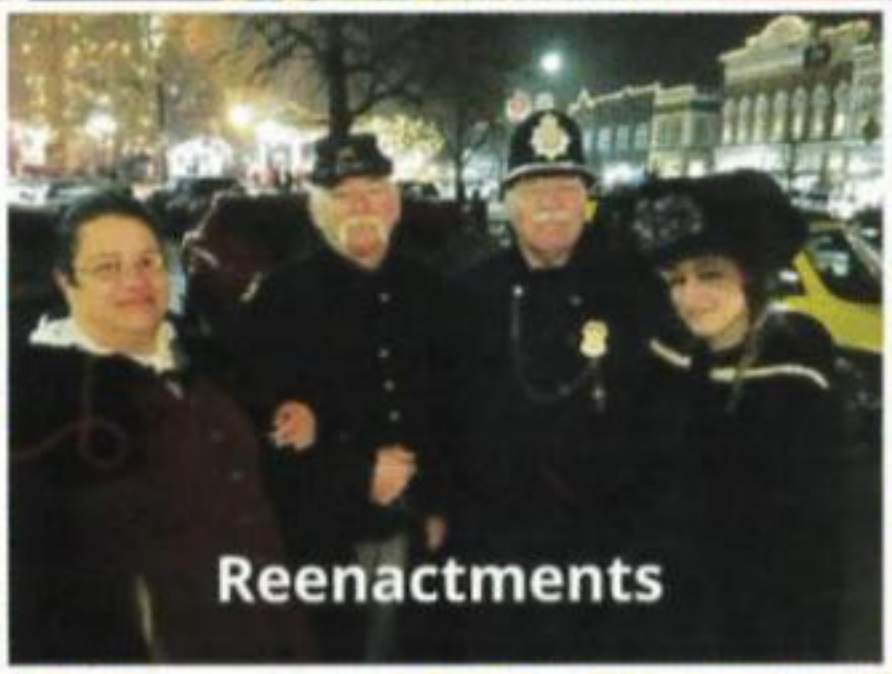
